2019 LGA Year In Review

We are winding up another year of activities in service to the membership and the Lake Gaston community. Among the activities we have completed are:

- Five County Forum local county managers and elected officials were brought together to meet and discuss items of interest among the five counties that make up the Lake Gaston area.
- Lake Clean Up our annual Spring event that spruced up the lake and surrounding communities prior to the Summer vacation season.
- Lakeside Learning Day we had middle school students from Gaston Middle School to visit the lake for a day of learning about Lake Gaston and a variety of curriculum-related subjects.
- Annual Community Shred Event we provide a commercial shredder service for all to use. "Bring out your shred!"
- Lake Revegetation Project built, repaired and restocked protective cages to help encourage the growth of native plants beneficial to the lake ecosystem.
- Lake Vegetation Survey all 350 miles of the Lake Gaston shoreline was surveyed in support of the ongoing efforts to manage the invasive aquatic plants in the lake. Catch the details elsewhere in this issue.
- Meet The Candidate Forums were held in Brunswick and Mecklenburg Counties in Virginia prior to the local elections.
- Five County Superintendents Forum local county school Superintendents were brought together to meet and discuss items of interest among the school systems of five counties that make up the Lake Gaston area.
- Helped get the safety buoys permanently stationed at the Eaton Ferry Bridge and are pushing to get the required navigation lighting installed to improve boating safety on the water.

All of these accomplishment are made possible by the volunteer work by you and some of your neighbors. We all thank you for the support that helps make Lake Gaston a truly wonderful place and community.

Don't let the December/January Bulletin be your last

We hope you had a wonderful Thanksgiving and had time to relax with your families. Maybe you had a chance to get to the lake and kick back and get in a little fishing. Now it's the run up to Christmas and we know renewing your membership for 2020 will probably take a back seat. We can understand that. We will be sending you a reminder the beginning of January, so we will catch you then.

However, in case you want to take care of business now and don't have our renewal letter in hand, you could either mail your check to LGA, P.O. Box 656, Littleton, NC 27850 for either one of the following membership levels: General \$25, Bronze \$50, Silver \$100, or Lifetime \$250; with a note of any changes.

Or, you could go on line and pay by credit card. Click on www.lakegastonassoc.com/Membership/JoinForm.htm which will take you straight to the on-line form. After completing the required fields and indicating any changes that need to be made to your membership record, go to the bottom of the form and click on the "Make Payment and/or Submit Info" box, and that will get you on the path to pay by credit card or PayPal (if you want to pay us with money from your PayPal account).

If you want to renew your business online, follow the same steps above and select Business \$50.

Note: when renewing on-line, make sure you fill in the *required fields i.e. Application type (choose renew), Name, email address & confirm email address, or you won't be able leave that screen when you get to the bottom and click on Submit info / Make Payment.

If that happens, scroll back up and complete the *required field you missed, and then you will be able to proceed to the on-line payment choices. You don't have to fill in the other fields if your information (lake address, mailing address etc. has not changed.

As we said earlier, we will be sending out a reminder the first week of January and hopefully if you have not renewed at the time, you will be able to do so before the end of January.

Your positive impact on Lake Gaston's water quality

With cooler autumn weather and fall colors comes the chore of leaf raking and getting our lawns and landscapes ready for the winter.

Please remember that what we do here along the Lake Gaston shoreline impacts the aquatic plants, animals and our water quality.

Keeping as many leaves and yard debris out of the lake helps reduce nutrient loading, silt build-up and oxygen depletion which can lead to high levels of algae.

Your actions have an impact on the lake environment and help maintain Lake Gaston's great water quality.

2019 Fall Vegetation Survey is complete

Volunteers floated all 350 miles of Lake Gaston's shoreline in October and November conducting our annual vegetation survey. What awesome weather we had this year with minimal storm activity.

This field data on what and where vegetation is growing along Lake Gaston's shoreline is a vital component in vegetation management. Jessica Bauman, Extension Associate for Lake Gaston with NC State University's Aquatic Plant Management Program will now analyze this data along with other information, such as biomass sonar and treatment results, to assess and direct management activities of invasives such as hydrilla and Lyngbya.

Once the survey data is analyzed and compiled we will be sure that this information is shared with you.

Thanks to all the volunteers, too numerous to mention, who contributed to this effort. A special thanks to Bruce Johnson who did an awesome job of solo kayaking a great deal of the shoreline.

Virginia Citizens for Water Quality Summit

Al Potter and Jeff Zimmer attended a Water Quality meeting in October at Randolph Macon College. It was a great opportunity to network and learn about other group's efforts in monitoring water quality.

The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality shared survey data that shows there are approximately 1300 volunteers collecting water quality data providing 82,000 hours of their time for a value of over \$2 million dollars each year. This shows the importance of volunteers in monitoring water quality and the significant value they provide.

Clean water in our streams, rivers, and lakes has huge benefits to our environment and quality of life.

LGA volunteers have been collecting water samples over the last five years to determine the presence of E. coli. We plan to continue these efforts and will report results out later this year.

From the Desk of the Executive Director

As you know our annual Membership Drive starts September 1 and anybody joining from that time through the end of the year gets the rest of this year and all of next. I'm responsible for processing their entry into the LGA with their welcome letters and overseeing the administration of the entry into our membership data base.

In September we sent out a mailing to Northampton county lake property owners (not currently with the LGA) to encourage them to join. New members have been coming in from that avenue. We also have new members who have joined because they know a LGA member who sponsored their membership – both get a \$5 discount – new member joins at \$20 and the LGA member listed on the Sponsor line of the application gets \$5 when they renew their membership.

Another avenue of new members is via our local realtors who give a complimentary membership to their new lake home/lot buyer. The number of realtors in this program is growing.

At the beginning of October each year I run the renewal notices. At the end of September we had 1,997 members paid thru December 31, 2019 (1,090 of that number are covered by their HOAs, see list below). Thank goodness for mail merge to produce the individual renewal notices that C-Line Graphics then prints & mails for us.

And then I send invoices to the treasurers of Bruns-Del Estates (Brunswick Estates, Clydes Retreat, Delbridge Estates), Eaton's Ferry Estates, Ferncliff, Hunter's Creek, Jack's Landing, Laura Woods, Long Branch Shores, Merrymount, Pasture Gate, River Forest, Roanoke Shores, Summerwood, Timber Creek, Timbuctu and West Winds Homeowner Associations for their 2020 dues.

Traditionally, the renewals slow up as our members start to focus on preparations for Thanksgiving, and then during early December renewals are coming in fast again.

Typically we have received about three quarters of the renewals by year end & reminder notices are run and mailed the first week of January. As you know, the grace period ends January 31, and only our members who have renewed for 2020 will get the February/March Bulletin and our information emails. Hence the article in this issue "Don't let December/ January Bulletin be your last."

Each year the amount of members who renew on line via credit card on the LGA website increases – this year is no exception. When you are renewing and have no changes to report, you need only complete the required fields (indicated in red to the right of the box) i.e. application type; name, email address; confirm email; and then select payment type near the bottom of the form. The majority of those transactions are successful.

Occasionally a member may experience difficulty on the payment section. You have the choice of using your credit card or your PayPal account (if you have one). When you click on your payment choice you will be presented, for example if using a credit card, with the fields you need to complete. After you have reviewed your answers & confirmed payment, you will receive a confirmation response before you exit that your transaction was successful. You will very quickly (within minutes) receive a receipt via email confirming your successful transaction.

When the on-line payments arrive at the LGA, they come in twos – a copy of the application you completed and a copy of confirmation of payment. I print out the application and print the payment confirmation on the back & that information is used to update your membership database record for 2020.

Every child gets a book, so appropriate books for different age levels (books boys may enjoy are often hardest to find) will be appreciated. Balls, dolls (ethnically diverse), art supplies, craft/model kits, small handheld electronic games, toy cars and trucks, watches or inexpensive jewelry for older children, etc. also are typical of the types of gifts given in the past.

John 3:16 recommends that we limit the cost of any gifts to under \$15 & that most of the items listed can be found for \$10 or less.

Personal Shoppers - Assist parents in choosing the presents for their children. This added step lets us get the know the families even more as a volunteer "shops" with them in our store set up in the Littleton UMC Fellowship Hall from December 12-19th. Volunteers would need to sign up for at least a two-hour period one of these days.

Wrappers

Wrappers will assist the parents in wrapping their children's gifts after their shopping appointments, December 12-19th between 9am and 5pm until all of the presents have been wrapped. All supplies including tape, paper, scissors, boxes, etc. will be provided. We will be wrapping in the Littleton UMC Fellowship Hall.

Party People

The Christmas parties will be held December 21st at 11am, 12pm, and 1pm at The Center. Volunteers would need to arrive at 10am. Of course, volunteers are welcome to help later in the day if they cannot make it at 10am. Volunteers help in many areas including serving food, as Santa's elves, helping with parking and taking gifts to the car.

Public Safety news and safety tips

Since this input is for safety awareness, there is a challenge of how to have suggestions become action. If there is no action, the article is just noise. So please, if you read something that might make your life safer, take action now, not later or tomorrow.

Before the bitter cold drops in and being in the wind off the water becomes really miserable, take the time to secure dock items and all watercraft, so that when spring comes there are not more surprises than you can handle. Winterizing personal watercraft and powered boats, while having a cost, is definitely less costly than repairs after damage from hard freezing temperatures.

Vessels need to be lifted out of the water with structure folded away or removed so that high water does not result in vessel or dock damage, and remember it never hurts to have a line tying vessels to docks even on lifts. The use of heavy duty tongue locks, or wheel boots or a removed wheel may stifle a theft of a boat or jetski stored in the driveway.

Look out for your neighbors and try to have ways to contact them if there is an issue with their property or an area power or water outage. Have a friend check on you when the weather is bad.

Make sure that items around the home do not scream out that there is no one home. Have a neighbor watch for handbills on doors, phone books in driveways, open doors, fallen trees, out of location trash receptacles, overgrown yards, or broken water lines.

Make sure that proper preparation for winter is taken to avoid severe damage to a residence. Disconnect water hoses from outdoor spigots and drain hoses. Ensure batteries are fresh in Smoke Detectors and install Carbon Monoxide Detectors if heating or cooking with gas.

Employ surveillance cameras as a neighborhood or individually for property protection. Let local Sheriff Departments know the property will be unused for a time and most will perform random checks of entryways. Don't leave valuable assets vulnerable to theft in an unoccupied residence; record serial numbers and have proper property insurance for your valuables.

Part of preparing for the colder months is thinking about the condition of wood burning stoves and their chimneys. Proper maintenance is key to avoiding chimney fires, and proper ventilation is critical to avoid carbon monoxide poisoning. Buy the salt pellets now and store them where they will be needed when you go out for the mail or paper, or to keep

from falling on your own steps. A small investment could save your life and those of your loved ones.
